There is an area alongside the Pasadena Freeway called Sycamore Grove that in the early days of Los Angeles was a verdant landscape that was manna for Bohemian artists and socialites alike.

Some years back, preservationists saved from demolition 8 historic homes from different parts of the city and managed to plant them in this Arroyo location. They named the location Heritage Square. In the same area, in 1898, the idiosyncratic house named El Alisal was begun by Charles Lummis. Lummis, who famously walked from Cincinnati to LA to work for the LA Times, spent 10 years building his home out of river rock. He said that he wanted it to "last a thousand years".

We are going to visit these representatives of early Southern California architecture in this lovely setting south of Pasadena. Come join us for a fun day – transportation by luxury bus, tours by docents and lunch at one of League members favorite restaurants, Saladang Song in Pasadena.
